For each quilt you wish to register, you must submit one entry form and one photo.

Tips for writing your quilt's "story" for the show: What was your inspiration? Did you make it for a special person? To commemorate a special event? Did you learn this technique in a class? Don't forget to give your quilt an interesting title!

Tips for submitting a photo of your quilt: A small photo (approximately 3"x 5": or 4"x 6" is preferred. No need to print your photo on expensive photo paper - copy paper is fine.

- **Challenge Quilt** "[Celebrating America](#)" To Celebrate America's 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the challenge is to depict our wonderful country in any way you wish as long as it is no bigger than 100" around the perimeter. A sleeve is required.

All quilts must have a sleeve sewn, not pinned, to the back. Quilts 25-108" wide will need a 4" sleeve, while those under 25" can have a 2" sleeve. Instructions for making and attaching a sleeve for hanging can be found all over the web - or just ask a friendly member of the guild.

Each member of the guild is encouraged to enter a quilt in the show.

Each entrant must be a current guild member and must have participated in the making of the quilt.

Entries must not have been exhibited in a previous FCQG Quilt Show.

The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to edit quilt descriptions.
