## Disappearing Half Square Triangle (HST)

These instructions make 2 blocks, 8 inches finished.

## 1-10-inch square White Fabric

## 1-10-inch square Pastel Fabric - think spring

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white square. Place the white square and the pastel square rights side together. Sew a $1 / 4$ inch away on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Press to the pastel and trim to $91 / 2$ inches square. You now have two HST.
- With one HST at a time, measure and cut 2 inches in from all 4 sides.

- Swtich the White rectangles with the Pastel rectangles. Sew the block together. The block is now $81 / 2$ inches square.
