Ten Minute block

1 – 10-inch Red Square

1 – 10-inch Black Square

- Take the 2 squares of fabric and with right sides together, sew a 1/4" seam around the outside of the block (all four sides).
- Next cut the block diagonally from corner to corner to make 2 triangles.
- Take one triangle and make a 2 ½" cut on each side of the sewn seam. Repeat with the other triangle.





• In the corner of each triangle is a 2 ½" square. Unsew one side of each square, open and press to the black. Open the other pieces and press to the black. Lay out the pieces as shown and sew together in 3 rows.





• Join the rows together to form the block. Square the block to 11 ½" square.
