

FRANKLIN COUNTY QUILTERS GUILD - BOM

The BOM presented at the June meeting is called Filmstrip. This patchwork block is 12 ½" unfinished. You are encouraged to get your creative juices flowing and pick out fabrics that remind you of summer, the outdoors, picnics, birds, bugs, sunshine and flowers. You may use any background fabric, fussy cut center piece, and associated squares. I think the block was named filmstrip because you can create a block that creates an image of what makes you think of summer. Bring one, two or more blocks to the July meeting. The lucky winner might even be able to make a picnic blanket.

Center Fussy Cut Block

(1) 4 ½" x 4 ½" square (A)

Background (your choice of color or print)

2 rectangles 1 ½" x 4 ½" (B)

2 rectangles 1 ½" x 6 ½" (C)

2 rectangles 1 ½" x 10 ½" (E)

2 rectangles 1 ½" x 12 ½" (F)

8 squares 2 ½" x 2 ½" (DB) background square

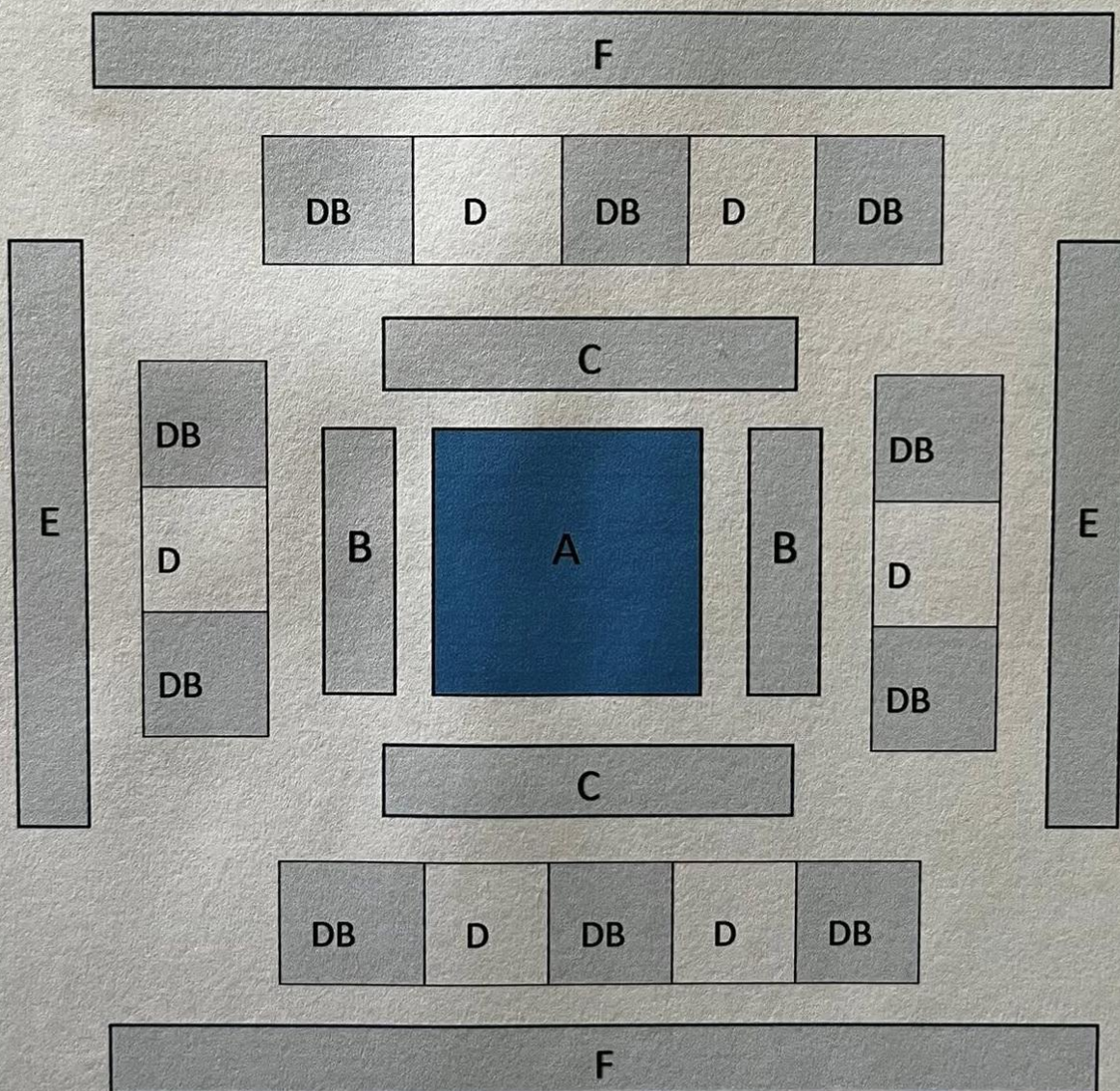
Accent Squares (total of 8 – they may all be the same, or 2 sets of 4 squares of differing patterns or colors, or whatever you decide)

Total of 8 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares (D) accent squares

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FILMSTRIP BLOCK – unfinished size 12 ½' x 12 ½''

Piece in alphabetical order, like a potato chip block.
